OPENING TIMES: The Library is open to the public from 9:00 to 17:00 Monday to Thursday, and 9:00 to 16:00 Friday. We are open most school holidays except public holidays, Christmas week & the month of August.

HOW TO BORROW: Books, DVDs & CDs may be taken out by residents from Monaco and the nearby regions in France and Italy. Those wishing to borrow books/recordings must become a member. Please complete the Reader Membership Form and provide the required documents:

- **Proof of identity & residency:** *carte d'identité, carte de séjour, passport, student card, utility bill &c.*
- **Membership fee per year:** 20€ adult; 35€ couple; 15€ for university students (valid for the duration of studies). All members enjoy the first lecture they attend at the library for free (during Q1 January-March 2026). Thereafter lecture/concert tickets cost €10.
- **Family membership fee per year** 40€; or a child can become a member 8€/child (8€ covers membership until 18 years old).
- **Loan Specifications:** Members may borrow up to 4 books & 2 DVDs/CDs for six weeks, renewable several times, unless the title has been requested by another reader. Renewal can be made by telephone or e-mail: info@pgil.mc

READERS' RESPONSIBILITIES: Readers are responsible if a borrowed book/recording is damaged or lost - the member must pay to replace it.

Membership Fees:

- Adults - €25 (to be renewed every year)
- A couple €35 (to be renewed every year)
- Children/Students (18 years old or younger) - €8 (one-off payment: membership lasts until the child is aged 18 years old or when the student finishes studies at university/third-level education)
- Family - €40
